Significant Criminal Events:

TYPE OF INCIDENT: Gunshot - Assault w/Intent to Commit Murder

COMPLAINT NUMBER: 12-685

INFORMATION: On January 19, 2012, at approximately 7:06 p.m., Pittsfield Police officers responded to 2224 Golfside Road (Lexington Club Apartments) for multiple 911 calls of a subject down on the ground and bleeding. Upon the officers' arrival, they found a 33-year old Ypsilanti resident suffering from a gunshot wound to the head. The victim was unresponsive and transported to the hospital and is currently in critical condition. After obtaining a description of the suspects, three individuals were detained. Investigators learned that two subjects, ages 15 and 16, met the victim at the Lexington Club Apartments, just prior to the shooting. At approximately 10:30 p.m., officers surrounded the suspect's apartment and took into custody the 15 and 16-year old males along with a 19-year old male. Based on evidence gathered and information obtained at the scene, both of the juvenile suspects were taken into custody and later lodged at the Washtenaw County Juvenile Detention Facility and the 19-year old male was taken to Washtenaw County Jail pending review of charges. Pittsfield Officers' were also provided assistance by the Washtenaw county Sheriff's Department and Michigan State Police Crime Lab.

Officers are on scene and the investigation continues. This does not appear to be a random act and investigators believe the shooting may be drug-related. **UPDATE (1/23/12) **

On January 21, 2012, all three suspects in this incident were arraigned. Charles Johnson, 15-years of age, was charged with Conspiracy to Commit Robbery- Armed and Assault with Intent to do Great Bodily Harm. Both Farai Munetsi, 16- years of age, and Steven hall, 19-years of age, were charged with Conspiracy to Commit Robbery-Armed. All three subjects were given a \$500,000.00 cash bond.
