Washtenaw County Road Commission: Plowing subdivisions, what to expect during and after a winter storm.

The Washtenaw County Road Commission (W.C.R.C.) is responsible for maintaining more than 1,650 centerline miles of county roads, in addition to maintaining 581 lane miles of state highways within the county. The W.C.R.C. has 46 salt trucks/snowplows that can be found on the roads at any given time during a winter storm event. Home Invasion: 2012-1244

On February 5, 2012 at approximately 9:00 am, the Pittsfield Township Police Department received a call from a resident in the 4600 block of Shellbark Drive needing to report a home invasion. An officer made contact with the home owner who advised that during the night an unknown suspect stole loose change from an unlocked vehicle that was parked in the driveway. The homeowner also stated that the suspect entered the garage which was also open and entered the house, stealing a purse that was left just inside the entry.
