Type of Incident: Larceny from a Building

Complaint # 13-1818

On February 17th 2013, Pittsfield Township Police responded to a report of two charity jars with an unknown amount of money stolen on February 16th, 2013 at the Speedway Gas station in the 4000 block of South State Street. The incident occurred around 9:32pm. An unknown black female approximately 20 years old, 5'5, and 175 pounds was seen leaving with both jars.

Type of Incident: Vehicle Impound/Violation Of Graduated License/ Reckless Driving/Obstruction

Complaint # 13-1883

On February 18th 2013, at 11:34pm Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2600 block of Northridge Court for a noise complaint. Upon arrival officers discovered a large party with over seventy-five juveniles in attendance. Officers believed that 25 to 30 juveniles ran from the rear of the home into the neighborhood. Officers discovered a large quantity of alcohol at the rear of the home. A 2000 Nissan Altima left the scene at a high rate of speed and was discovered abandoned in the area a short time later. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was later identified. All of the juvenile's parents were contacted and released to them.

Type of Incident: Stolen Vehicle

Complaint # 13-1894

On February 17th 2013, Pittsfield Township Police responded to a resident in the 2200 block of Glencoe Hills Drive for a report of a stolen 2002 Mazda Protégé that occurred sometime between February 17th and 18th 2013. The owner of the vehicle was notified that the Detroit Police Department had recovered his vehicle on February 18th 2013.

Type of Incident: Larceny of a License Plate

Complaint # 13-1900

On February 18th 2013, Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 3400 block of Carpenter Road where a resident reported someone had stolen the Michigan license plate from a 2005 Chrysler 300 that he was given permission to drive.

Type of Incident: Minor In Possession/Resist And Obstruct A Police officer

Complaint # 13-2036

On February 23rd 2013, Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 6400 block of Bedview Drive to a noise complaint and loud party. Officers attempted to make contact with the homeowners but no one would answer the door. After talking with people outside of the home officers allowed those individuals to leave the area. One person was discovered passed out in a vehicle in front of the home and was transported by HVA to the hospital. Officers continued to check the area and observed four young males near the rear of the home. The males ran away when they were noticed by the police. When they were asked to stop, they did not comply and ran through neighborhoods, across Michigan Avenue North and into the Pittsfield Preserve. One of the suspects fell to the ground and was taken into custody.

Type of Incident: Breaking and Entering

Complaint # 13-2043

On February 23, 2013, at 6:15pm, the Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2700 block of Carpenter Road for a reported breaking and entering that occurred sometime between February 22nd – 23rd 2013. Upon arrival, an employee reported that someone had kicked in the back door of the business and stole a printer and three CD players.

Type of Incident: Malicious Destruction Of Property

Complaint # 13-2062

On February 23rd 2013, the Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2000 block of Bent Trail Court for a report of a rear window that had been broken out of a 2001 Dodge Caravan. It appears nothing was stolen.
