Survey: “Identity Theft on the rise again, card victims jump by two million annually”

On February 22, 2012, The Javelin Strategy & Research group released its 2011, report on fraud using consumer’s credit cards. In 2011 identity fraud increased by 13 percent. More than 11.6 million adults became a victim of identity fraud in the United States, while the dollar amount stolen held steady, according to Javelin Strategy & Research. In the report, it provides an overview of the information being obtained from social media sites such as LinkedIn, Google, Twitter, Smartphones and Facebook. WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Total Calls for Service year to date: **415**

On February 24, 2012, at 10:45pm, Report #400. Firefighters responded to a reported cardiac arrest in the 3000 block of Morgan Road. Fire crews arrived to find a victim with no pulse or respiration and started CPR. Firefighters then inserted an advanced airway and continued CPR until a pulse and respiration returned. The patient was transported to the hospital by HVA and was breathing on his own with a stable blood pressure at that time. The airway that was inserted is part of the new Basic Life Support techniques that Pittsfield Township Fire Department is approved to use.

INFORMATION: Pittsfield police are investigating a report of a felonious assault, in which an unknown suspect stopped his car and pointed a black handgun at a 17 year old female and a 15 year old male as they were walking on Central Blvd. The victims, both Pittsfield Twp. residents, apparently had words with the suspect as he passed, which prompted him to turn around and confront them with the handgun. The suspect then left the area without further incident. The suspect vehicle is described as an older model, silver, boxy car, with no hood, and a loud engine. There were no injuries or arrests made.

Suspect(s): Unknown Asian male, 19-25 years, wearing prescription eyeglasses with a purple and black long sleeve shirt.
