The Federal Trade Commission:
“The Truth About Cell Phones And The National Do Not Call Registry”

Contrary to a re-circulating email, there is no new cell phone national do not call database. There is **only one** National Do Not Call Registry. It is operated by the Federal Trade Commission and covers both cell and landline phone numbers. Registering your phone number/s is free. Once registered, a number stays on the Do Not Call Registry until the registration is canceled or service for the number is discontinued. Type of Incident: Mutual Aid - Hazmat Incident

Fire Complaint # 522

On March 11th 2013, Pittsfield Township Fire Department sent two members of the Technical Rescue Team to a crash on US-23 and Six Mile Road. A truck driver lost control of his dual-trailer truck after blowing a tire. The trailer rolled over onto a passing vehicle and trapped the driver. He did not survive. There were no other injuries in the accident.

Type of Incident: Structure Fire

Complaint # 556

Information: On March 17th 2013, at 3:50pm Pittsfield Township Fire Department received a report of smoke coming from a mobile home in the 3400 block of Carpenter Road. On arrival, crews found heavy smoke and fire coming from the rear of the residence. The fire was under control in approximately 20 minutes and firefighters remained on scene for two hours performing overhaul and investigating the cause of the fire. The resident was not home at the time of the fire. No one was injured.

Further Information: The cause of the fire was not suspicious and remains under investigation by the Fire Marshal.

Type of Incident: Arrests Made For Three Pittsfield Township Home Invasions

Complaint# 13-1781

On February 16, 2013, three homes in Pittsfield Township (3000 block of Appleridge and the 3900 block of Highlander Way West) were broken into between the hours of 2:00 am and 4:00 am. Property was stolen. A collaborative effort with Ann Arbor Police Department resulted in the arrest of Javare Holmes, an 18 year old male resident of Ann Arbor. On March 12, 2013, the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office charged Javare Holmes with three counts home invasion in the first degree. Holmes is currently lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail.

Type of Incident: Larceny From A Motor Vehicle

On March 12th 2013, at 10:14am Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 4700 block of Washtenaw Avenue for report of a larceny of a handgun from a Chevrolet Uplander mini-van. There were no signs of forced entry into the vehicle. The incident occurred between 9-9:30am.

On March 15th 2013, at 12:20am Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 4100 block of Green Meadows Blvd. for a report of a person breaking into a vehicle. When police arrived a suspect who matched the known description was stopped, questioned, and arrested for breaking into a 2007 Pontiac G6. The suspect was also in possession of drugs and drug paraphernalia.
