The Federal Trade Commission (FTC), the nation's consumer protection agency, along with state and local law enforcement agencies, and consumer organizations across the country, are getting complaints from consumers about unsolicited robocalls. At the same time, individuals and businesses that have nothing to do with blasting the illegal robocalls are being blamed for these calls because their phone numbers are being misused by unscrupulous telemarketers. INFORMATION: Pittsfield Township Police Officers were dispatched to the 2100 Block of Glencoe Hills Drive, for a larceny from motor vehicle complaint. An anonymous caller advised that there was a Dodge Durango in the middle of the parking lot with its doors open. The caller then advised that they could see two or three people under a Cadillac that was parked under the car port, removing the tires and placing them in the Durango. Officers arrived on the scene, the suspects fled north into the woods where one suspect was apprehended. The suspect, a 24 year old Detroit resident, was arrested and lodged at Washtenaw County Jail, pending the prosecutors review. The vehicle that the suspects were loading the tires in returned as stolen from the 2200 Block of Glencoe Hills Drive. The other suspect(s) have not been identified as of yet and this is an ongoing investigation. Anyone with information pertaining to this case is requested to contact the department at 734 822-4911.
