WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Total Calls for Service year to date: 669

March 31, 2011, The Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to the report of a structure fire in the 6000 Block of Warner Road. Fire crews arrived to find a large barn fully involved in fire. Fire fighters brought the fire under control in less than an hour but worked for several hours to extinguish hot spots. The attached barn suffered fire and smoke damage but was not severely damaged. This fire is under investigation and deemed as arson.

While fire crews were still on that scene, they received the report of another structure fire on Hunter's Ridge Drive. Crews scrambled from the scene and arrived to find a two-story house with heavy smoke and fire showing. Fire crews initiated an interior attack and extinguished the fire. One occupant of the house was transported to the hospital via HVA with severe burns. Fire fighters were able to rescue several pets. The Saline Area Fire Department assisted on both fires. This fire is under investigation and damage was estimated at approximately \$175,000.00.

April 2, 2011, The Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to the report of a brush fire in the 100 Block of Bemis Road. Fire crews arrived to find at least one acre on fire and rapidly spreading. Fire crews were able to stop the fire before it damaged any structures. Saline Fire Department assisted at the scene.

On March 31, 2011 at approximately 2:30 pm, officers were dispatched to the 6700 block of Warner Road to assist the fire department on a structure fire. Officers were advised by witnesses that two teenagers were seen walking to the barn earlier and then observed running from the barn as the fire was burning. Witnesses were able to describe the subjects along with providing a license plate of the vehicle they left in. Detectives were able to identify, locate and arrest both subjects who later confessed to starting the fire. The subjects were lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail and the case was submitted to the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office for charges. Both subjects were charged with one count of Arson of Real Property which is a 10 year felony.

The subjects have been identified as Kyle Clossick, 17 years of age, York Township resident and Nicholas Arhangelos, 17 years of age, Pittsfield Township resident. Kyle Clossick was given a P.R. bond at arraignment and Nicholas Arhangelos was given a \$10,000 / 10% bond at arraignment.
