Pittsfield Charter Township Ordinance No. 205 bans outdoor open burning except in areas zoned AG (agricultural district). In these areas, open burning is allowable with notification to the Fire Department. Other types of open burning such as for recreational purposes do not require prior notification, although the Fire Marshal reserves the right to prohibit any open burning during a fire alert, warning, or when atmospheric or local conditions make such burning hazardous. Type of Incident: Domestic Violence, Malicious Destruction of Property/ Attempted Home Invasion

Complaint # 13-3481

On March 31st 2013, at 5:00pm, Pittsfield Township police responded to the 3400 Block of South State Street for a report of person who had kicked in a door and broke the window but did not gain entry. A suspect was taken into custody.

Type of Incident: Larceny from automobiles

Complaint # 13-3547

On April 1st 2013 at 9:40pm, Pittsfield Township police responded to the 4700 block of Washtenaw to a report of a larceny from a 2002 BMW. The incident occurred between 5:30- 9:30pm. The victim reported that someone had broken out the rear passenger window and had stolen her purse. A second victim reported that her 2009 G6 Pontiacs rear passenger window had been broken out and her purse stolen. The third vehicle a 2012 Ford Escape had the front window broken out and a purse stolen.

Type of Incident: Breaking and Entering

On April 7th 2012, at 11:28am Pittsfield Township police responded to the 5800 block of Plum Hollow Drive for a reported Attempted Breaking and Entering of a shed. The incident occurred April 1st – 2nd 2013; a pad lock was cut off a shed door. The employees discovered after the initial report that a leaf blower had been stolen.
