Information: On April 15, 2012 at approximately 4:20 am an officer while on patrol observed a subject matching the description of a suspect wanted for robbery in the City of Ann Arbor. The officer made contact with the subject and while speaking to him determined that he was not related to the Ann Arbor incident. The officers were though able to determine that he had been spray painting graffiti on the US-23 Bridge over Packard Rd. The subject was arrested and released pending review by the prosecutor's office. Further investigation has revealed similar graffiti damage in other jurisdictions that is believed to be from the subject. The Pittsfield Township Police Department is working with the Ann Arbor Police Department, Washtenaw County Sheriff's Department, and the Michigan State Police.

INFORMATION: On April 19, 2012 at approximately 10:20 am an officer with the Pittsfield Township Police Department observed two male subjects walking along the side of the road in the 2500 block of Hawks Ave. Due to an increase in home invasions in the area occurring in the daytime the officer stopped and made contact with the subjects. While speaking with the subjects they advised they were on probation for home invasions. A search of a backpack revealed burglary tools. The subjects were taken into custody at that time and transported back to the station where they were processed and later lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail. A report will be submitted to the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office for review.

The investigation is continuing in regards to possible connections of previous home invasions in the area.
