Robbery Armed: # 2011-3823

On April 19, 2011 at approximately 9:43 pm, officers were dispatched to the 4700 block of Washtenaw Ave. for a report of an armed robbery. Upon arrival the officers made contact with the victim, a 22 year old Ypsilanti resident. The victim stated that he was seated in his vehicle when he was approached by two black males who asked to use his cell phone. The victim gave one of the suspects his cell phone to use and then both suspects produced handguns and pointed it at the victim. The suspects took the victim's car keys, gold necklace, and cell phone. The suspects left the area in an unknown direction on Packard Road in a gold Malibu, possibly an early 2000 model, with tinted windows. The victim was unharmed. As of April 26, 2011 the victim has refused to cooperate with the detectives.

Unlawful Imprisonment: # 2011-3840

On April 20, 2011 at 1:44 pm, officers along with detectives responded to the 3000 block of Hawks Ave. for a report of an attempted kidnapping. Dispatch had received a 911 call from a twenty three year old female resident reporting that her ex-boyfriend had just attempted to kidnap her at gunpoint. Officers responded to the area in attempts to locate the suspect while additional information was obtained from the victim.

The victim was walking out of her residence when the suspect jumped out of a vehicle parked in the street. The victim ran back towards her house but the suspect was able to catch her, grab her and threatened her with a firearm. The suspect then dragged the victim back to his vehicle and threatened to shoot her if she attempted to runaway. Once in the vehicle the suspect displayed the firearm and was yelling at the victim who was in fear for her life. The suspect then began driving away and when the vehicle came to a stop sign the victim attempted to jump out. The suspect grabbed her and assaulted her until she was able to get away. The suspect fled the area in his vehicle and the victim was able to call 911. A witness to the incident assisted the victim until the police arrived.

The suspect, Kwame Hampton, a 28 year old Westland resident was later arrested in an wooded area behind a family members house in Inkster City. The case was presented to the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office and Kwame Hampton was charged with Unlawful Imprisonment, Felonious Assault, Felony Firearm, and Domestic Violence.
