WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

The Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to a reported house fire in the 5100 block of Hickory Pointe Blvd. First arriving units found a two story house with flames on the exterior of the house from the first floor all the way to the roof. Fire crews entered the house and extinguished the fire which had spread to the interior of the house and the attic. There were no injuries and the damage is estimated at approximately \$60,000. The fire started near the electrical meter but it is still under investigation.

Home Invasion: 2012-5398

On May 17, 2012 at approximately 3:48 pm a 12 year old resident of the 2100 block of Arbor Circle returned home to find a male subject standing outside in front of a window. The resident also noted the screen lying on the ground next to the subject. The subject then told a second subject it was time to go at which time the second subject exited through the front door. Both suspects then took off running from the scene. The resident was able to provide a detailed description of both suspects and a responding officer located one of the suspects coming out of a wooded area. The suspect was taken into custody and later lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail.

On May 19, 2012 the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office authorized one count of Home Invasion 2nd degree for Deane Cochran, 20 year old Pittsfield Township resident.
