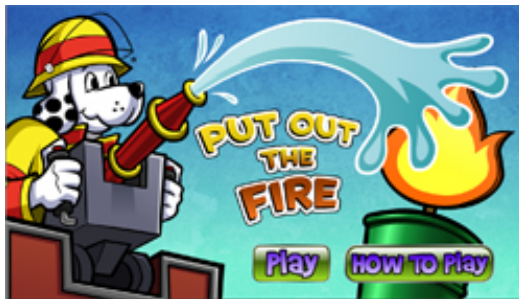
WEEKLY FIRE REPORT
