WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Home Invasion: # 2011-5378

On June 1, 2011 at approximately 12:52 pm, the Pittsfield Township Police Department received a call from a resident in the 2600 block of Foster Ave. reporting a home invasion. The resident advised the responding officers that he left earlier in the morning around 10:00 am, and returned home just prior to calling the police. He advised that when he entered the house he noticed his television was missing and the window over the kitchen sink was broken. The homeowner then checked his house and discovered a computer, camera, and a handgun missing. The rear door wall was also open and assumed to be the way the suspect left the location. A K-9 track was attempted with negative results. A total amount for the stolen property was not immediately available at the time of the report.
