Homicide Investigation: # 2011-5931

On Tuesday, June 14, 2011 Pittsfield Officers were requested by the Merrillville Police Department, Indiana, to respond to the above location to investigate the welfare of a 45-year old female resident of Pittsfield Township. Upon arrival, the officers made contact with a 55-year old male resident and learned that the 45-year old female, identified as Dawn Marie Fital, W/F, 6-8-66, had been missing since Monday, June 13th. Also, investigators in Merrillville, Indiana had informed Pittsfield Police that a subject was taken into custody and is believed to be Ms. Fital's boyfriend. Based on information provided by Merrillville Police, investigators from the Pittsfield Police Department and the Michigan State Police - LАWNET responded to Merrillville, IN and gathered evidence that substantiated Ms. Fital's disappearance from Pittsfield Township and supporting evidence of a homicide investigation. Based on information compiled through the investigation, the whereabouts of a body believed to be Dawn Marie Fital, was found in a stream, near Hobart, Indiana. The identity of the human body and the autopsy is currently being investigated by the Lake County Medical Examiner's Office.

Based on extensive information compiled during the investigation, the case was submitted to the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office on Thursday, June 16th for homicide review.

Following review of the case, the prosecutor's office authorized a felony warrant of Homicide - Open Murder for Gregory Noack, and charging him with the murder of Dawn Marie Fital of Pittsfield Township.

Gregory Noack has waived extradition and is currently lodged at Lake County Indiana Jail pending extradition to Michigan.

Pittsfield Police investigators are working in conjunction with law enforcement authorities from Merrillville, Indiana as well as other law enforcement agencies, including Federal Bureau of Investigation, Michigan State Police, Saline Police Department and the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office.
