Home Invasion: #2010-6056

Officers were dispatched to the 4000 block of Munger Road for a reported home invasion that occurred on June 17, 2010 between 12:00 pm and 7:00 pm. Officers located the point of entry which was a second floor window that was left open. The suspect entered the home and went through all three bedrooms stealing jewelry. Residents are reminded to keep all windows and doors locked and to immediately report any suspicious activity.

Domestic Violence / Flee & Elude Police / Operating while Impaired: #2010-6092

On June 18, 2010 at approximately 8:40 pm, officers were dispatched to the 2200 block of Glencoe Hills Drive for a report of a male assaulting a female. While en-route officers were advised that the male suspect was leaving the scene in a white SUV. Officer Kabat observed the vehicle on Glencoe Hills Drive and then initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle on Carleton Drive. As Officer Kabat was attempting to make contact with the suspect, the suspect pulled away and Officer Kabat initiated a pursuit. The suspect continued through

the subdivision pulling into the driveway of a residence on Oakdale Drive. The suspect ran into an open garage disobeying orders from Officer Kabat to stop. As the suspect was attempting to gain access to the residence Officer Kabat warned the suspect that he would be tasered if he did not obey the orders. The suspect then turned and began approaching Officer Kabat in an aggressive nature. At that time Officer Kabat deployed his taser striking the suspect resulting in the suspect falling to the ground and being taken into custody. While Officer Kabat was taking the suspect into custody it was evident by the odor of intoxicants that the suspect was under the influence of alcohol. The suspect was arrested and lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail. The victim sustained minor abrasions from the incident and did not require any medical treatment. The suspect, a 48 year old Pittsfield Township resident has been charged by the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office with Robbery, Fleeing & Eluding Police, Resisting & Obstructing a Police Officer, Domestic Violence, Operating a Motor Vehicle While Impaired, and Interfering with an Electronic Communication Device.
