Waters Road closure effective June 22nd - August 31st, 2012

On Friday June 22nd, 2012, a temporary road closure will be imposed on Waters Road between Wagner Road and Gallinger Drive for the construction of road improvements. The posted detour for the temporary road closure of Waters is Wagner Road, Scio Church Road, and Oak Valley Drive. Access to Waters Road traffic will be maintained during the closure.

Armed Robbery Comerica Bank, 6/23/12 Update: 2012-6225

The suspect in the armed robbery of the Comerica Bank 2795 Carpenter Road, that occurred on June 6, 2012, at 11:28 am, has been identified as Travis Neboyskey Floyd, a 30-year-old Ann Arbor resident. Detectives of the Pittsfield Township Police Department actively investigated this incident; conducting search warrants at several locations and developing leads that identified Floyd as the perpetrator.

Floyd was arraigned on June 23, 2012, at the Washtenaw County Jail, where he was being held on unrelated charges. He was charged with two felony counts of Robbery Armed and issued a \$50,000 cash bond.
