Felonious Assault Investigation: # 2011-6157

On Tuesday, June 21, 2011, Pittsfield Officers were dispatched to the 4000 block of Green Meadows Blvd for a large group of people engaged in a fight in the parking lot. Upon arrival, officers identified a 21 year old resident who reported that a fight broke out between the victim, his cousin, and a group of unknown individuals after the victim and his cousin observed a subject assaulting a pregnant woman in the parking lot. The subject who was assaulting the woman went to an unknown apartment and brought a group of unknown subjects with him and a fight began between the victim, cousin, and the unknown subjects. During the course of the fight an unknown female was swinging a knife around and an unknown male produced a black handgun and fired one shot in the air. The victim was then assaulted by the subject with the handgun there were no injuries. Pittsfield officers and investigators are continuing the investigation into the incidents. Robbery Investigation: #2011-6317

On Sunday, June 26, 2011, Pittsfield Officers were dispatched to the area of Washtenaw Avenue near Glencoe Hills Drive for reports of a female crying and a male knocking on doors seeking help because someone was trying to shoot him. Officers made contact with both parties and it was determined that a robbery had occurred on the 2200 block of Glencoe Hills Drive. It was reported that the male and female, non-residents, were in the area to visit a friend. They reported that they were standing at the male victim's vehicle in the parking lot when an unknown black male about 6' to 6'2" tall with a slim build last seen wearing a gray t-shirt and black pants was armed with a possible semi-automatic black pistol approached them. Both the male and female fled the area. When both were returned to their vehicle, it was discovered that a cell phone and wallet were stolen. The incident remains under investigation. Home Invasion Investigation: #2011-6330

On Sunday, June 26, 2011, Pittsfield Officers were dispatched to the 3600 block of Fieldcrest Lane for a reported home invasion. The victim reported that his home was broken into via a window while he and his family attended church. It was found that multiple areas of the home had been rummaged through and items were prepared to be stolen from the home, however, were not. It was discovered that some cash was taken from the home. Residents advised they witnessed a white male, in his early 20's, wearing a plain white t-shirt and blue jeans talking on a cell phone run from the victim's backyard north before losing sight of him.
