WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Significant Fire Events:

Electrical Fire 4900 Block of Pitchpine Lane, #1439

On July 15th, 2012, The Pittsfield Township Fire department responded to an electrical fire in the 4900 Block of Pitchpine Lane that was contained in one unit. The Ypsilanti Fire department was called to assist due to other Pittsfield Fire units responding to another call.

Grass Fires: # 1438, #1453, #1482, # 1489, and #1490

On July 15th, 17th, and 21st, Pittsfield Township Fire personnel responded to a grass fire in the 4000 Block of Platt Road where two acres burned. The second incident was at I-94 and State Street for a brush fire contained to one acre. Pittsfield Township fire personnel also responded to State Street and Payeur Road for a brush fire that consumed one to two acres.

On July 19th, Pittsfield Township Fire personnel responded to US-23 and Washtenaw Avenue for a rollover crash. The jaws of life were used to free the entrapped occupant.

On July 21st, Pittsfield Township Fire personnel responded to Crane and Merritt Roads for a large brush fire in a wheat field that covered five to six acres. Mutual aid was provided by Augusta and Saline Fire departments.

Felonious Assault: #12-8032

INFORMATION:

On July 16th, 2012, at 11:37am Pittsfield Township Police Officers were dispatched to 6190 West Michigan Ave. for a stabbing complaint. Officers arrived on scene and discovered two people had been stabbed. During the investigation, it was discovered that a 32-year-old male from Saline had an altercation with a 46-year-old male from Brooklyn, Michigan.

The altercation began as a verbal argument inside the restaurant and continued outside to the rear of the parking lot. The suspect, the 32-year-old male; produced a knife and stabbed the victim several times. During the altercation, the victim was able to obtain the knife from the suspect and stabbed the suspect several times. Both were transported to St. Joseph Hospital. The victim has undergone surgery for his injuries.

Injuries: Multiple stab wounds on both suspect and victim.

Suspect (s): 32-year-old male from Saline, MI.
