On August 1, at approximately 11:22 p.m., Pittsfield Police officers responded to the 3100 block of Woodland Hills Drive for a report of a subject bleeding and asking for help. Upon the officer's arrival, they found a 31-year old Pittsfield Township resident suffering from a gunshot wound to the head. The victim was able to tell the officers that prior to being shot in the head; two suspects had forced their way into his apartment and struck the victim in the face with a handgun. The victim was transported to the hospital and is currently in critical condition.

Officers are on scene and the investigation continues. This does not appear to be a random act and investigators believe the shooting may be drug-related.
