Complaint: #12-9622

Information: On August 23rd, 2012, at 6:54am, Pittsfield Township police responded to the 4100 block of E. Morgan Rd. for a stabbing. Police are searching for Luis Alberto Munoz-Cerda, a 23 year old male resident of Pittsfield Township, regarding this incident. He is known to frequent the Ann Arbor, Pittsfield Township, and Ypsilanti area. The initial incident occurred on Thursday, August 23, 2012, at Hong Far Food Service, when Munoz-Cerda and another employee had an altercation which escalated to a stabbing. The victim received several stab wounds and is currently recovering.
