Often called the silent killer, carbon monoxide is an invisible, odorless, colorless gas created when fuels (such as gasoline, wood, coal, natural gas, propane, oil, and methane) burn incompletely. In the home, heating and cooking equipment that burn fuel are potential sources of carbon monoxide. Information: On Friday, September 6, 2013, at approximately 10:26 a.m., Pittsfield Township Police officers responded to 3200 Carpenter Road on a report of a bank robbery at the Best Bank. The suspect had left the scene prior to police arrival. The suspect passed a note to the teller indicating he was robbing the bank and wanted money. The suspect was given an undisclosed amount of money containing a dye pack. The suspect exited the store and walked to an older model white vehicle. When the suspect got inside the vehicle the dye pack exploded, emitting a red dye on the suspect and on the inside of the vehicle. It is believed that the explosion of the dye pack may have possibly burned the suspect's hands.

The suspect is described as a black male between ranging between 5'4" to 5'9" tall, thin build, wearing black hoodie and black pants with a beard as a disguise. He was seen getting into an older model white vehicle and leaving the scene. ****UPDATE**** - The suspect was wearing bright white tennis shoes with either black shoe laces or the top of the shoe near the shoe lace area is black in color. Also, the suspect is wearing blue jeans not black pants as previously stated.
