WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Total Calls for Service year to date: 1785

On September 16, 2010, in the 4500 block of Swiss Stone Lane, Pittsfield Township Fire Fighters responded to a kitchen fire at the above address and found a working fire in the kitchen area. Fire fighters initiated an interior attack and quickly extinguished the fire. The cause appeared to be accidental in nature. No injuries were reported and a damage estimate was not available.

On September 18, 2010, Pittsfield Township Fire Fighters were called to a possible structure fire in the 4100 block of Diamond to find smoke coming from the house. Fire fighters investigated to find a fire in the clothes dryer in the basement of the home. The fire was contained in the dryer and fire fighters removed the burning items. No injuries were reported.

On September 18, 2010, Pittsfield Township Fire Fighters responded to the 4500 block of Concourse for a sign on fire that was attached to the building. Fire crews arrived, disconnected the electricity to the sign, and extinguished the fire. An estimate of the damage to the sign was not available at the time of the report.

Larceny From a Motor Vehicle: 2010-9437

On September 13, 2010 an officer was dispatched to the 3900 block of Palisades Blvd for a report of a larceny from a motor vehicle. The victim reported that an unknown suspect entered his vehicle which was in his driveway and stole his car radio along with an iPod. On September 19, 2010 the victim contacted the department and advised that he believed he had located his radio on Craigslist. A meet was arraigned with the seller and while officers were in the area the victim confirmed that the radio being offered for sale was his. The suspect, a 24 year old Ypsilanti Township resident was arrested and lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail for being in possession of stolen property.

Possession with Intent to Delivery Heroin: 2010-9596

On September 17, 2010 Officers were in the 3100 block of Woodland Hills Drive when they observed what appeared to be a male attempting to break into a vehicle. The officers made contact with the subject who advised the vehicle belonged to him. Officers observed heroin on a plate along with a scale on the passenger seat. The subject then fled on foot from the officers. The subject was found and taken into custody without any further resistance. A search warrant was obtained and a total of twelve grams of heroin along with more than \$1300.00 in cash was seized. The subject, a 21 year old male from Detroit, was arrested and lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail.
