Type of Incident: Motor Vehicle Accident - Extrication

Complaint #: 12-2230

Information: On November 3rd. 2012 at 8:01am, the Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to a motor vehicle accident on Eastbound I-94 near State Street. Fire crews arrived to find a three vehicle accident with multiple injuries. Two patients in one vehicle were pinned in and required extrication. Both patients were transported to the hospital in critical condition. One patient in another vehicle was pronounced dead on the scene. Fire fighters from Ann Arbor assisted at the scene.

Smoke Detectors: Change the batteries

On Sunday November 4th 2012, clocks were set back one hour. When you change your clocks it's a good time to remember to replace smoke and carbon monoxide alarm batteries. Batteries should be changed at least once a year, unless they are 10 year lithium. If smoke alarms are hardwired you still need to replace them in case of a power outage. Information: On November 3rd 2012, at 4:44am the Pittsfield Township Police responded to 3676 South State Street for a breaking and entering in progress. A witness called 911 and reported that the suspect, a 30 year old male from Ann Arbor, was trying to kick in the front glass door of the Allstate Insurance Office. Officers responded and located the suspect leaving the scene. Officers arrested the suspect and he was lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail pending review of charges by the Washtenaw County Prosecutors Office.

Information: On November 5th 2012, at 12:59pm the Pittsfield Township Police responded to a burglary alarm at The Harvest Moon Café in the 5400 block of East Michigan Avenue. Upon arrival, officers located a suspect fleeing the business on foot. After a short foot pursuit, officers were able to apprehend and arrest the suspect. It was determined that the alarm was valid and the restaurant had been burglarized. The suspect was subsequently lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail on resisting and obstructing police, burglary, and parole violation.
