WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Total Call for Service – Year To Date: 2,277

Significant Fire Events:

Type of Incident: Motor Vehicle Accident - Extrication

Location: East Bound I-94 near State Street

Complaint: # F 12-2230

Information: On November 3rd 2012, at 8:01am the Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to a motor vehicle accident at the above location. Fire crews arrived to find a three vehicle accident with multiple injuries. Two patients in one of the vehicles were pinned in and required extrication. They were transported to the hospital in critical condition. One patient in another vehicle was pronounced dead on the scene. Fire fighters from Ann Arbor assisted at the scene.

Further Investigation: Michigan State Police

Type of Incident: Multi Vehicle, Multi Patient, Pin-In, Injury Crash

Location: Moon Road at Michigan Avenue

Complaint: # F12-2245

On November 6th 2012, at 12:05am the Pittsfield Township Fire Department responded to a crash at the corner of Moon Road and Michigan Avenue for a multiple vehicle accident with injuries.

The front and rear seat passengers of the vehicle (a Camaro) were transported to St. Joseph's Mercy Hospital in critical condition. The driver was transported to the University of Michigan in stable condition.

The driver of a second vehicle was transported to the University of Michigan in critical condition after he was extricated from the car using hydraulic rescue tools.

The driver of the third car was treated on the scene and did not require transport.

Saline Fire Fighters were requested for mutual aid to assist the Pittsfield Township Fire Fighters with the extrication and patient care.

All of the patients were transported by Huron Valley Ambulance.

Injuries: 4 patients, 3 critical, 1 pinned.

Type of Incident: Car vs. Pedestrian. Fatal Crash

Location: Golfside Road north of Washtenaw Ave

Complaint: # 12-12524

Information: On November 8th 2012 at 5:49pm, Pittsfield Township officers responded to the above area for report of a car/pedestrian injury crash. A 59 year old Ypsilanti Township resident was crossing Golfside Road when she was struck by a sedan traveling south bound causing her serious injury. The victim was transported to the hospital for treatment and died later from her injuries. The driver of the vehicle was not injured during the incident.

Injuries: Fatal

Further Investigation: To be conducted by Pittsfield Township Police Accident Investigation Team.
