WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Total Calls for Service year to date: 2,451

On December 13th, Pittsfield Township Fire Department responded on over 20 weather related motor vehicle accidents all resulting in no or minor injuries. One fire department vehicle was struck by a motorist because of the driving conditions – this resulted in very minor damage and no injuries.

Fire fighters were called to a vehicle fire at the above location and arrived to find a passenger vehicle fully involved. Fire fighters extinguished the fire and determined that the fire was caused by a mechanical malfunction.

Breaking & Entering: 2010-12768

On December 14, 2010 at approximately 10:00 am an officer was dispatched to the 4700 block of Washtenaw Ave. for a report of a breaking and entering. Upon the officer's arrival the manager of the business stated that sometime between 2:45 am and 9:45 am, an unknown suspect forced entry into the

office and stole an undisclosed amount of cash. Evidence from the scene was collected and the case remains under investigation.

Felonious Assault: 2010-12814

On December 17, 2010 at approximately 7:15 am, officers responded to the 2000 block of Arbor Circle West for a report of a person who had been assaulted with a taser. Upon officers arrival they made contact with the victim, a 36 year old Pittsfield Township resident. The victim advised he answered the door after hearing a knock and when he did the suspect reached towards him and tasered him. The victim stated he was able to slam the door closed on the suspects arm causing the suspect to pull the taser away from him. The victim was then able to close the door and call the police. A K-9 track was conducted and the track ended in a nearby parking lot. The case remains under investigation and anyone having information is requested to call the Pittsfield Township Police Department.
