Crime Map For The Week Of September 29th - October 5th 2013

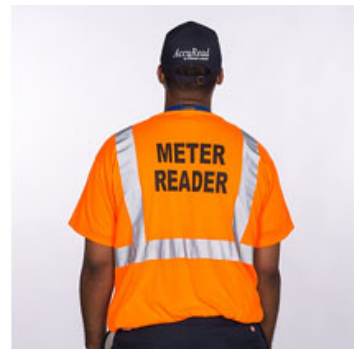
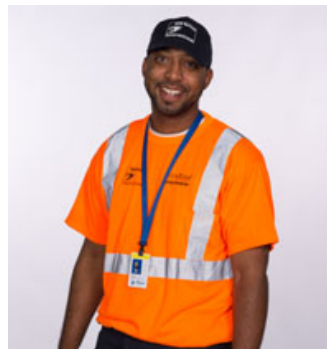

DTE Meter Readers: New Uniforms

Wondering if someone is actually a DTE Energy meter reader? All meter readers wear a photo identification badge. Always ask to see the badge to make sure the person is a DTE Energy representative. You should deny access to anyone claiming to be a utility representative who does not display an identification badge. DTE has also changed the way meter readers look. DTE Energy meter readers in many communities have new high-visibility orange uniforms.

The new uniforms promote safety by making meter readers more visible to traffic and pedestrians. All meter readers within the city of Detroit are now wearing the new uniform.
