Type of Incident: Armed Robbery

Complaint # 13- 13624

Information: On November 12, 2013, at 12:30am, Pittsfield Police responded to a report of an armed robbery in an apartment complex in the 4800 block of Packard Road. The victim, a 57 year old male resident of Pittsfield Township, reported he parked his car and was walking into his apartment building when approached by two suspects. One of the suspects produced a handgun and demanded the victim's personal property. The victim surrendered his property and both suspects fled in a vehicle. The victim was not injured during the incident. A local broadcast for the suspect vehicle was put out to area law enforcement agencies. University of Michigan Police located the suspect vehicle in their jurisdiction, stopped it and detained two suspects. Evidence related to the crime was found in the vehicle. The suspects were turned over to Pittsfield Police and were lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail on charges of armed robbery.
