COMMUNITY EVENTS – INFORMATION

Washtenaw County Road Commission: Carpenter Road Improvements- Bemis Rd. to Merritt Rd.

Beginning Monday, May 12, 2014, the Washtenaw County Road Commission will close Carpenter Road between Bemis Road and Merritt Road. The posted detour route will utilize Bemis Road west of Carpenter Road, Platt Road, and Michigan Avenue (U.S. 12) west of Carpenter Road. Access to property owners between Bemis and Merritt Roads will be provided from the north at the Merritt Road intersection. All other motorists and road users will be required to follow the posted detour route or use another alternative route.

Carpenter Road is expected to be reopened to traffic by Saturday, May 17th, or sooner. However, this date is tentative and is **weather dependent**.

Fire Incident: Structure Fire

Information: On April 29, 2014, at 2:24 a.m., the Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to a house fire in the 2500 block of Foster Avenue. First arriving companies found heavy smoke and fire conditions extending from the garage into the second floor of the home. Crews experienced heavy fire conditions on the second floor but were able to stop progress of the fire while determining the home was not occupied. Pittsfield crews were assisted on scene by the City Of Ann Arbor, Ypsilanti City, Ypsilanti Township and Superior Township Fire Departments. The cause of the fire remains under investigation by the Pittsfield Township Fire Marshal's Division.
