Snapchat Settles FTC Charges that promises of disappearing messages were false. Snapchat also transmitted users' location and collected their address books without notice or consent.

SnapChat, one of the most popular mobile apps used by teens and young adults promised that their messages and photos transmitted would disappear in ten seconds after posting.
