WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Total Calls for Service, Year to Date: 1,682

Fire Incident: Trench Collapse
Complaint # 14-1658

On July 30, 2014, at 4:05 p.m., Pittsfield Township Fire personnel responded to the 6500 block of North Maple Rd. for a person involved in reported trench collapse. While digging a trench along the foundation wall of a single family home, a large portion of the trench collapsed, trapping a 53 year old male approximately 8 feet below ground level.

The victim was trapped from his waist down, conscious and alert.

The Washtenaw County Tech Rescue Team and Pittsfield Firefighters, totaling 44 personnel, had the victim removed in 2.5 to 3 hours. After shoring the unstable trench wall, dirt was removed from around the victim by hand, shovels, and mostly by utilizing a Pittsfield Township Utilities Dept. vac truck. A second vac truck was provided by the Saline Utilities Dept.

HVA and TRT paramedics provided care to the victim and he was transported by Survival Flight, still conscious and talking.

Pittsfield Township police closed S. Maple Rd. several times during the incident for emergency vehicles and as a precaution while Survival Flight landed.

The threat of rain and potential high wind gusts were monitored by the Washtenaw County Director of Emergency Services during the incident.
