Information: On August 7, 2014, at 7:37 p.m. Pittsfield Township police responded to a report of a shooting that occurred in the driveway of a home located in the 4100 block of Persimmon Drive. The victim, a 41-year-old male resident of Ypsilanti Township went to the suspect's residence and argument began. The suspect, a 33-year-old male resident of Pittsfield Township pulled a gun on the victim during the verbal dispute. The gun was held against the victim's forehead, causing the victim to sustain a minor injury to his forehead.

The victim was transported to St. Joseph Hospital for treatment and was later released. The suspect was taken into custody and was lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail for the assault.

Update: The Washtenaw County Prosecutors Office has denied charges against the suspect.
