Pittsfield Township (June 7, 2010) -- Mandy Grewal, Pittsfield Township Supervisor reminds all Washtenaw County residents of the free Shredding Day on June 26 from 9am-12noon at the Township Administration Building, 6201 W. Michigan Avenue (SW corner of Platt and Michigan Avenue/US-12). The shredding event is open to all Washtenaw County residents and businesses with a limit of 3 banker size boxes or 100 pounds per resident or business. Co-sponsored by Allshred Services, the free and secure shredding event will be held rain or shine.

"Pittsfield Township is expanding its efforts of environmental stewardship and public service. The free shredding day is the second part of our 2010 trifecta that includes a Spring Clean-Up Day and a newly added Fall Clean-Up Day," Grewal noted. "Our Spring Clean-Up Day was a huge success. We experienced a 311% increase in vehicles over 2009. A staggering 31,000 pounds of electronics (up 415%) and 23.93 tons of rubbish (up 167%) were dropped off and disposed of responsibly. These items might have otherwise ended up as contaminants in landfills or as bags of trash on the roadside."

"I encourage people to mark their calendars and plan to take advantage of this free opportunity to dispose of personal and sensitive documents in a secure fashion," Grewal commented. Documents will be shredded on-site to ensure that the materials are not seen or handled by others.
