**Washtenaw County Emergency Management: Emergency Preparedness Resources**

All families should be prepared to sustain themselves for a minimum of a full 72 hours for any community emergency that may happen such as a major winter storm or an outbreak of tornadoes. Here are suggestions to help your family prepare for any disaster:

First, download our new [Community Emergency Preparedness Workbook & Guidelines](#) (3 MB .pdf). This brochure is full of information about our risks, what supplies you should keep stocked in your home, and how to develop a disaster plan for your family.

Second, have a portable, battery powered AM/FM radio, flashlight, and plenty of spare batteries. Know your local Emergency Alert System broadcast stations. In Washtenaw County, they are **WEMU at 89.1 FM, WWWW at 102.9 FM, WQKL at 107.1 FM, WTKA at 1050 AM and WLBY at 1290 AM**. Always depend on these local stations to provide you with real-time emergency information for the Washtenaw County community. Metro Detroit broadcasters are not required to provide, and often don't provide, emergency information for Washtenaw County residents.

Third, if having electric power is extremely important to you, consider having a qualified electrician install an emergency generator before a disaster strikes. Finding and installing a generator during an emergency is difficult and it can be extremely dangerous!

### **Information:**

On Monday November 17, 2014, at 11 p.m., PTPD Officers were dispatched to Green Valley Ct for a report of a suspicious suspect ringing door bells and trying door handles. While at that location, an additional call of the same type of was reported on Sun Valley Dr. A PTPD officer located a home with its door open. While there, an officer observed a subject running from the neighborhood on Maple Road. The subject was detained and investigation determined that the suspect had indeed broken into the home on Sun Valley Drive and stolen multiple items.

The suspect also stole an item from the home on Green Valley Ct, and broke into another garage at an unknown location in Ann Arbor, Scio Township (possibly Uplands Subdivision), or Pittsfield Township.

Investigation determined that a large, nearly full, bottle of wine was stolen from the garage of the unknown location. Change from an Audi vehicle parked in the same garage was also stolen. This is believed to have occurred between 8:30 p.m. and 11:30 pm on 11/17/14. Police are seeking the public's help in determining this unknown location and ask residents in these areas to check if their garage was entered with these items stolen.
