**Washtenaw County Emergency Management:**  
**Emergency Warning Sirens testing March – September 2015**

Washtenaw County's 81 warning sirens will be tested at Noon on Saturday, March 7th. If there is threat of severe weather on the day of a test, it will be cancelled.

Except for scheduled testing, the sirens will be activated for the following emergencies:

- The National Weather Service has issued a tornado warning
- A Severe thunderstorm has been detected with damaging winds in excess of 70 MPH
- A hazardous materials accident requires immediate protective action by the public
- An attack on the United States is imminent, underway or has recently occurred

Warning siren activation is a signal to members of the public to immediately go indoors and monitor local Emergency Alert System media outlets for official information.

On February 26, 2015, at 9:46 a.m., Pittsfield Township fire personnel responded to E. B. I-94 and Ann Arbor Saline Rd. to put out a vehicle fire.

**Fire Incident: School Bus Accident**  
**Complaint# 15-513**

On February 27, 2015, at 12:16 p.m., Pittsfield Township Fire Department was dispatched to a crash at Carpenter and Morgan roads involving two busses. Pittsfield Fire Department responded with three engines. Upon arrival Pittsfield Township Fire Department observed a two bus crash involving one bus that rear ended the other. Pittsfield Township Fire Department started to triage injuries to approximately 130 students.

Huron Valley ambulance responded and assisted Pittsfield Township Fire Department with injuries of twenty-two students. Pittsfield Township Police assisted with traffic control.

Representatives from Saline Area schools were on the scene quickly to help organize the students and make contact with the students' parents.

Ten students were transported to area hospitals by Huron Valley Ambulance, while the remaining students were treated and released to their parents. The parents of the non-injured were contacted and the students were released and transported back to the school.
