WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Fire Incident: Structure Fire
Complaint # 15-1433

On July 6, 2015, Pittsfield Township's Fire Department was dispatched to reports of smoke coming from a commercial building in the 700 block of West Ellsworth. The first arriving crew encountered smoke coming from the eaves of the building. After entry was made by the first crews they encountered heavy black smoke. The fire was located in two storage rooms and extinguished by the interior fire crews. There was fire and extensive smoke damage throughout the building. Ann Arbor fire department assisted with one engine crew for a rapid intervention crew. The cause of the fire is still under investigation. Damage is estimated at \$175,000 to \$200,000.

Information:

On July 10, 2015 at approximately 2:36 p.m., Pittsfield Police officers responded to 2700 block of Carpenter Road on a report of an attempt bank robbery at the Comerica bank. The suspect requested money from the teller and then fled the scene without taking any money. No injuries were reported.

The subject is described as a black male, between the ages of 50-60 years old, 5'8" to 5'10" tall with a medium build. The suspect wore a khaki colored button-down shirt with dark pants and a dark blue or black Detroit Tigers baseball hat with the old English D on the front.
