Home Security Tips: Burglary/Home Invasion

- Lock your doors and windows.
- Replace your strike plate screws with 2 ½" - 3" screws, so that they are secured into the doorframe.
- Pin your double hung windows, check out our website at www.pittsfield-mi.gov and select police department.
- Remove valuables from in front of windows or keep blinds/curtains closed. Keeping valuables out of sight is probably the single most important thing. If they don't see anything valuable, they will move on until they find someone's house where these precautions weren't taken.
- Do not leave purses and wallets on counter tops and on tables in the main areas of the house. Secure them in bedrooms or other secure locations.
- Do not store empty cans and bottles on your porch. This may attract subjects to your home.
- Engrave your property with a number or letters that will be easily identifiable to you if your property is stolen and recovered. IT is recommended that the driver's license number or state ID number be used.
- Take pictures of your property and keep them in a safe deposit box or at a safe location away from your home.

**Police Incident: Armed Robbery
Complaint # 15-11191**

Information: On October 5, 2015, at approximately 11:50 p.m., an unknown black male subject entered Motel 6 in the 3700 block of S. State St. brandishing a knife and demanded money. Once the robbery was complete, the suspect fled the area in a vehicle. Motel staff workers were not injured during this incident.

SUSPECT(S): The suspect is described as a black male, mid 20's, thin build, medium skin tone with a medium length goatee and possibly a thin mustache. The suspect was wearing a red Chicago Bulls baseball hat with the bull insignia on the front, a black shirt with a black Varsity style jacket.

On October 7, 2015, at 6:15 p.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to a home in the 50 block of E. Payer Rd. for a reported Home Invasion. The suspects entered the home through the living room window. A jewelry box was stolen and a diamond ring.

Police Incident: Assault with Intent to Murder / Felonious Assault
Complaint # 15-11394

Information: On October 10, 2015, at 11:40 p.m., Pittsfield Police Officers were called to a business in the 5400 block of W. Michigan Ave. for reported shots fired at a 20 year old female in the parking lot. Upon arrival they found the victim unhurt in the business parking lot. She stated that a 22 year old male was arguing with her friend, when she intervened the male subject pulled out a 9mm hand gun and fired the weapon between her feet. The suspect then fled the scene in a vehicle which witnesses were able to give officers his plate. The BOL, was put out and Dearborn PD, found the suspect in his car with a loaded 9mm gun. The suspect was taken into custody and lodge at the Washtenaw County Jail.

****UPDATE**:** On October 12, 2015, defendant Hussein Ali Bazzi, was arraigned at the 22nd Circuit Court and charged with Assault with a Dangerous Weapon (Felonious Assault) and Weapons – Felony Firearm. A \$10,000/10% bond amount was ordered and defendant Bazzi is scheduled to appear for upcoming court proceedings.

SUSPECT: Hussein Ali Bazzi, 22-years-old, Dearborn Heights resident.
