### Federal Bureau of Investigation: New micro-chip credit card alert

NEW MICROCHIP-ENABLED CREDIT CARDS MAY STILL BE VULNERABLE TO EXPLOITATION BY FRAUDSTERS

By October 2015, many U.S. banks will have replaced hundreds of millions of traditional credit and debit cards, which rely on data stored on magnetic strips, with new payment cards containing a microchip known as an EMV chip. While EMV cards offer enhanced security, the FBI is warning Law Enforcement, merchants, and the general public that no one technology eliminates fraud and cybercriminals will continue to look for opportunities to steal payment information.

**Police Incident: Armed Robbery**  
**Complaint # 15-11604**

**Information:** On October 16, 2015, at 1:39 a.m. Pittsfield Township Police officers responded to the 4700 block of Washtenaw Ave. and were approached by a taxi cab driver who advised them he had been robbed.

The victim told officers he picked up the suspect in Ann Arbor and when they arrived at their destination in the Glencoe Crossing shopping Center the suspect threatened him with a knife and stole his cell phone. The PTPD/YPD K9 responded to the scene and tracked the suspect into the Golfside Lakes Apartment Complex.

During the track Pittsfield Officers were dispatched to a domestic assault in progress at an apartment within the Golfside Lakes Apartments. When the officers arrived for the domestic assault they found and arrested the armed robbery suspect. Stolen property was recovered at that time and the suspect was transported to the Washtenaw County Jail where he was lodged pending review of charges by the Washtenaw Prosecutors Office.

**Arrested:** 29 year old male Pittsfield Township resident.
