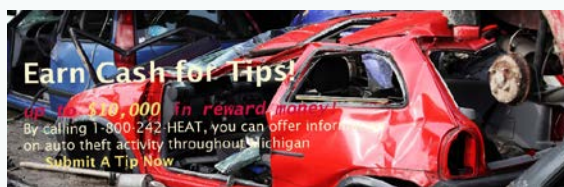
Larceny from Motor Vehicles: Ford Edge / Flex and others “theft of wheels”

Law Enforcement agencies from throughout Southeast Michigan has seen an increase in the theft of all four wheels from Ford and other SUV type vehicles. The two most frequent vehicles targeted are the Ford Edge and Flex. The majority of the vehicles do not have “wheel locks” installed and those are the targeted vehicles. The average costs to replace four 21 inch wheels, tires, sensors, and cap is between \$4,000.00 to as high as \$7,900.00. Residents are encouraged to obtain wheel locks to make your vehicle (s) a tough target to this type of theft. The average costs for the locks \$40.00 to \$60.00, check with an Auto Parts supply store or a dealership.
