


Redesign of CrimeMapping.com

The fire was extinguished and investigators remained on the scene dousing hot spots and trying to determine the cause. The patient was transported to the hospital in critical condition and didn't survive his injuries. This fire remains under investigation.

On May 17, 2016, at 6:58 a.m., Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2200 block of Glencoe Hills Dr. for a reported stolen 2013 Genuine Buddy 50 Moped Scooter.

Police Incident: Larceny from Motor Vehicle / Arrest
Complaint #16- 5796

On May 18, 2016, at 1:20 a.m., Pittsfield Police were patrolling area hotel parking lots due to recent larceny from automobile incidents. Police observed a 21 year old male suspect attempting to gain entry into numerous vehicles. Police attempted to make contact with the suspect and he fled on foot. The Officers caught the suspect who continued to resist arrest, resulting in police deploying a Taser at the suspect and taking him into custody. A subsequent investigation implicated the suspect in at least one previously unsolved larceny from automobile incident from the day before as well as a new one that had not yet been discovered by the victim. The suspect a 21 year old male resident of Canton Township was lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail on felony charges of resisting and obstructing police and larceny from an automobile.

The above named incidents remain under investigation.
