Since 2015, Wolverine Pipe Line Company (WPL) and Michiana Land Services, Inc. (MLS) have been in contact with you to explain and discuss WPL's proposed construction of a 16-inch diameter pipeline that will mostly parallel WPL's existing 16-inch pipeline, which crosses over and across property of which you are the owner of record.

This letter is to advise you that this project will commence on July 25, 2016, with WPL's crews and contractors working within WPL's defined pipeline easement area along portions of the approximate 35-mile project length. Survey crews will mark the easement area, tree clearing crews will remove the trees, grading crews will clear ground cover and then the main pipeline construction crews will commence within your property.

All encroachments within WPL's defined easement area must be removed by you before July 25, 2016. If these encroachments are not removed by you, WPL's contractors will remove them. It is also important that you notify any tenants you may have on this property of the upcoming WPL pipeline project.
