Phishing Scam Targets IRS Bogus E-mails Report Fake Tax Accounts Freeze:

Phishing e-mails, reported to be from the Internal Revenue Service, are targeting consumers with claims that their tax accounts have been locked and require immediate action to reopen. The e-mails, which appear to come from *info manager@irs.gov* and *support manager@irs.gov*, according to the latest in a round of phishing attacks aimed at the IRS.
