WEEKLY FIRE REPORT

Airplane Crash

Location: 801 Airport Dr., Ann Arbor Airport, Pittsfield Twp., Mich.

Information: During take-off the 2 seat overhead wing airplane crashed onto a grassy area at the NW end of the runway. The pilot was the only occupant, and due to the front end damage of the plane, was pinned inside the cockpit at both lower legs. The Pittsfield Fire Department used hydraulic rescue tools and reciprocating saws to remove the wreckage from around the pilot, who remained conscious and alert throughout the incident. Huron Valley Ambulance Paramedics monitored the pilot's condition, provided care, and once he had been extricated transported him to the University of Michigan Hospital.

Although fluids from the airplane, including gasoline, leaked from the wreckage, there was no fire. Flammable vapors were controlled by a fire department hose line. No other aircraft was involved.

The control tower closed the airport to all air traffic during the rescue and it remained closed while the Pittsfield Township Police Department remained on scene waiting for FAA investigators.

Injuries: (1) Male Pilot.

Further investigation: Pittsfield Twp. Police and FAA.

Home Invasion: 2012-3589

On April 1, 2012, at approximately 7:45 pm, the Pittsfield Township Police Department received a call from a resident in the 4000 block of Washtenaw Ave. reporting a suspicious vehicle in a neighbor's driveway. As the resident exited their house the vehicle pulled out and fled. The resident then reported the activity to the police department and an officer was dispatched to the area. Moments later the neighbor returned home and discovered their house had been broken into. Officers arrived on scene and discovered the suspect broke a window in the door allowing them to open it. Once inside the suspect stole stereo equipment, a computer, game system along with numerous CD's and DVD's.

The suspect vehicle is believed to be early 2000's Chevy Blazer or GMC Jimmy, tan or gold in color. The driver of the vehicle was not observed.

Unarmed Robbery: 2012-3622

On April 3, 2012, at approximately 3:01 pm, the Pittsfield Township Police Department responded to a report of a purse snatching in the parking lot of the Kroger store located at 3200 Carpenter Rd. Officers made contact with the victim, a 78 year old female resident of Ann Arbor. The victim explained that she had set her purse in the front seat of her vehicle while unloading groceries when a lone suspect opened the passenger door and took the purse, fleeing on foot. A witness was able to observe the suspect fleeing and last saw him heading north from the area of Carpenter and Packard Rd. The suspect was not located at that time. The woman was uninjured during the incident.

On April 4, 2012, at 8:00 pm the suspect was arrested by the Pittsfield Township Police Department. The suspect, Jason Hull, a 28 yr. old Ypsilanti resident was lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail. The case was presented to the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's office and the charge of unarmed robbery was authorized.
