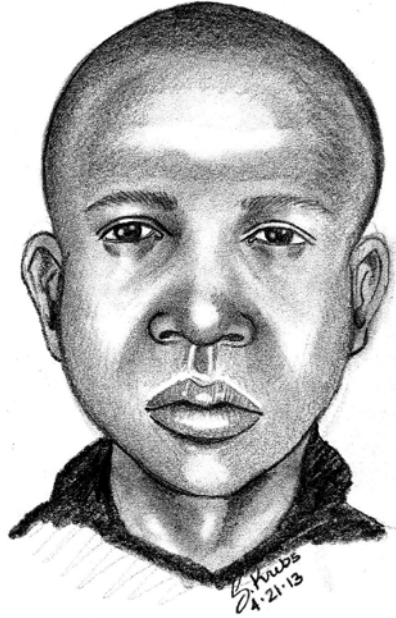
Complaint # 13-4276

Information: On April 19, 2013, Pittsfield Police officers responded to the 4900 block of Lakeridge Drive (Golfside Lake Apartments) on a report of a medical emergency. Officers responded to the scene and found that the female victim, a resident of Pittsfield Township, had been shot in the head during a robbery. Ann Arbor Police Department conducted a K-9 search with no suspect being located. The Washtenaw County Sheriff Department also assisted in the investigation attempting to locate the suspect. The victim was transported to the hospital where she received treatment for her non-life threatening injuries and remains in stable condition. The subject is described as a black male, thin build, approximately 5'8" tall, no facial hair, bald or closely shaven hair, wearing a blue or black hoodie and dark colored pants. Injuries: Gunshot wound to head

Information: ***Investigation has revealed that the suspect may have been near the AATA bus stop located at Washtenaw Avenue and Golfside Road just prior to the incident occurring on Friday, April 19th at approximately 10:35 PM. Those individuals utilizing the AATA along with those in the area of Washtenaw Avenue and Golfside Road are asked to be alert and aware of their surroundings at all times. Investigation continues and if the suspect is seen, please contact the Pittsfield Township Department of Public Safety immediately.
