Type of Incident: Malicious Destruction of Property

On April 22nd 2013, at 8:38am, Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 2800 block of Crystal Drive for a report of three tires slashed on a 2009 Cadillac. The incident is believed to have occurred on April 21st or April 22nd 2013.

Type of Incident: Larceny of a Handgun

Complaint # 13-4381

On April 23rd 2013, at 7:40am, Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 4500 block of Washtenaw Avenue to Enterprise Rental. A handgun was left in a rented vehicle by a customer. When the customer noticed he had forgotten his gun and returned to Enterprise Rental, the gun was gone. The incident occurred on April 22nd 2013 at 5pm.

Officers subsequently discovered two additional vehicles that had windows damaged in the same manner; a Chrysler Town and Country minivan and a 2002 Toyota Sienna minivan.
