Information: Pittsfield Fire Department responded to a motor vehicle accident on US-23 South of I-94. Fire crews arrived to find a vehicle that was headed Northbound had crossed all lanes of traffic and hit a tree on the southbound side of the highway. The lone driver was pinned in the vehicle and required extensive extrication due to the extent of damage to the vehicle. The "jaws of life" was used to extricate the driver who was transported to the hospital in stable but serious condition. Preliminary reports indicate that a medical condition may have caused the accident.

Injuries: Stable but in serious condition with visible injuries.

### **Strong Armed Robbery: 2012 - 4791**

Information: On May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012, at approximately 10:02pm, The Pittsfield Township Police responded to a report of a strong armed robbery of a pizza delivery driver who had just dropped off her delivery, in the 3100 Block of Evergreen Pointe Apartments. She was approached by two teenage males, who asked her for a menu. When the driver told them she did not have a menu, one of the subjects reached into her vehicle and took the change purse from the front seat. The victim attempted to take back her change purse and cell phone without success. While attempting to recover her property one of the suspects kicked her in the leg. Both suspects then fled on foot from the location.

Officers along with a police K-9 checked the area for the suspects, who were not located. There were no injuries and no arrests made.

Suspect (s): Two teenage black males, one wearing a white T-shirt, and the other one wearing a green T-shirt.
