**Effective June 18, 2012 until Further Notice - Airport Boulevard & Ellsworth Road**

Costco Warehouse Road Improvements Project:

On Monday June 18, 2012 a **ROAD CLOSURE** will be imposed on Airport Boulevard at the Ellsworth Road intersection. Airport Boulevard at State Street has been re-opened. **LANE CLOSURES** are still imposed on Ellsworth Road between State Street & Lohr Road and Airport Boulevard between Ellsworth Road & State Street. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be maintained on Ellsworth Road & Airport Boulevard and delays are expected during construction. Motorists are advised to **seek alternative routes**. These road improvements are related to the Costco Warehouse store which is scheduled to be completed by July 2012.

## **Waters Road closure effective June 22<sup>nd</sup> - August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2012**

On Friday June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012, a temporary road closure will be imposed on Waters Road between Wagner Road and Gallinger Drive for the construction of road improvements. ### **Significant Police Event:**

Breaking & Entering: 2012-6678

On June 16, 2012 at approximately 1:39 am, the Pittsfield Township Police Department received a call from a resident in the 500 block of Heartwood Lane reporting hearing loud bangs outside of their house and observing a subject standing in the yard. The caller reported the subject was dressed in all black. As officers arrived a subject was seen running from the area into a nearby cornfield. Officers chased after the suspect and determined there were two suspects involved. A K-9 officer from the City of Ann Arbor responded and began a track of the suspects. One of the suspects was taken into custody as he attempted to elude the K-9. The second suspect was not apprehended at the time.

Further investigation revealed that the suspects had thrown an object through a window of a home under construction in the area and gained entry.

The suspect, Jeffery Moore, a 30 year old Ypsilanti Township resident was arrested and charged with one count of Resisting and Obstructing. A future charge of Breaking and Entering may be authorized by the prosecutor after further information is obtained from the construction company.
