Michigan Fireworks Law: Statue 750.243. a defines fireworks as a device made from explosive or flammable compositions used primarily for the purpose of producing a visible display, audible effect, or both, by combustion, deflagration, or detonation. Michigan Law specifically prohibits all consumers' fireworks except for the following: Flat paper caps, toy pistols, toy cannons, toy canes, and toy trick noise makers as approved by the Michigan State Police and Sparklers. On June 21, 2010, Officers were dispatched to the 600 Block of Airport Blvd. for a reported breaking and entering of a business. There were no signs of a forced entry into the building located but the suspect did shatter a glass office door to gain access to an office. The suspect then broke into a cash box stealing an undisclosed amount of cash. The incident occurred over the weekend while the office was closed.

Home Invasion: #2010-6317

Officers were dispatched to the 4300 block of Central Blvd. for a reported home invasion that occurred on June 24, 2010, between 2:30 pm and 6:30 pm. The suspect pried open a side garage window to gain access to the garage while the home owner was out. The home owner returned and observed the window

open and several items out of place. Further inspection by the home owner revealed that a 19" red chainsaw had been stolen. There have been multiple incidents recently where items are being stolen from garages and sheds. Residents have been requested to watch for suspicious persons and report anyone they see walking through yards immediately.
