Type of Incident: Domestic Violence

Complaint #13- 7761

On July 7th 2013, at 3:46am Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 3400 block of Primrose Ln. for a report of a domestic assault that had occurred between acquaintances. One person was taken into custody for assault.

Type of Incident: Larceny

On July 7th 2013, at 1:30pm Pittsfield Township Police responded to the 3100 block of Ann Arbor – Saline Rd. for a larceny of a purse. The victim reported that she had left her wallet in a shopping cart and it was not there when she returned. The wallet was found in the store but missing was a cell phone, credit cards, and a driver's license.
