
Significant Fire Event:

Significant Police Event:

Receiving and Concealing Stolen Property

Complaint: #12-7306

Information: On July 1st, 2012, at 3:30am Pittsfield police responded to the 5500 Block of Michigan Ave. and Carpenter Rd. for a report of a male passed out behind the wheel of a vehicle. Officers made contact with the male and he was subsequently arrested for operating while under the influence of drugs. Inside of the vehicle Officers located property that did not appear to belong to the suspect, in addition to burglary tools. Officers continued their investigation and discovered a home that had an unreported burglary in Lodi Township. Property located in the suspect's vehicle was determined to have been taken during that burglary.

The Washtenaw County Sheriff's Department was then contacted and is investigating the burglary. Pittsfield Police have requested charges which include receiving and concealing stolen property, carrying a concealed weapon, operating under the influence of drugs, possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of burglary tools and minor in possession of alcohol. The suspect was lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail pending review of the case by the Washtenaw County Prosecutor's Office.

On July 2nd, 2012, the Washtenaw County Prosecutors Office authorized charges against Jeffery Sliskovic of Saline. Charges included Possession of Burglar Tools, Possession of Stolen Property, and Carrying a Concealed Weapon.

Breaking & Entering

Complaint: #12-7499

Information: On July 5th, 2012, at 2:34am, Pittsfield Twp. Police responded to an alarm in the 4800 Block of Carpenter Road, which is licensed medical marijuana grow facility and discovered a break-in had occurred. The suspect was located as he attempted to exit the building and flee from the officers with stolen marijuana, valued at an estimated \$40,000. He was taken into custody without incident and lodged at the Washtenaw County Jail, pending arraignment.

Arrested: 33 year old, male, Livonia resident, the suspect's identity has not been released at this time (pending arraignment 7-6-12). The requested charges in this case include Burglary (forced entry of a non-residence), Possession of Burglary Tools, and Possession with Intent to Deliver Marijuana.

On July 6th, 2012, the Washtenaw County Prosecutors Office authorized one count of Breaking and Entering along with one count of Possession of a Controlled Substance with the Intent to Deliver. Arrested is Phillip Holland of Livonia.
