Aggravated Assault and Battery: # 2011-6726

On Tuesday, July 5, 2011 at approximately 7:32 pm, the Pittsfield Township Police Department received several calls regarding a person being assaulted at Rave Cinema, 4100 Carpenter Rd. Upon the officers arrival the victim, a 25 year old Ann Arbor resident was located as well as the suspects mother. The victim stated that he was driving his vehicle past the drop off location when the suspect's mother's vehicle was blocking the roadway. The victim indicated that he honked his horn at which time the mother made a hand gesture towards him.

The victim then stated he yelled something in return to the mother and drove around her and parked his vehicle. As the victim approached the front doors of the cinema he was approached by three young males, one of them the son of the vehicle he honked at. The son, a 15 year old Ann Arbor resident, asked the victim what he had said to his mother and got up close to him. The son then began hitting the victim multiple times then slammed him to the ground. The victim stated that when he hit the ground his head hit the ground. The son and his friends then went inside and as the officers arrived they were able to locate his mother in the parking lot. The son was arrested and lodged at the Washtenaw County Juvenile Detention and was later charged with aggravated assault.
